

### THE EDMUNDO O'GORMAN SCHOLARS PROGRAM

The Edmundo O'Gorman Scholars Program provides financing for short-term (four to eight-week) visits to Columbia by scholars and scientists from any discipline who are working in Mexican institutions of higher education. The Program is supported by the National Council on Science and Technology (CONACYT) of Mexico; its purpose is to strengthen scholarly ties between Columbia and the academic and research community of Mexico. Its name honors Edmundo O'Gorman (1906-1995), one of the most influential Mexican historians of the twentieth century.

Appointments are available for any four to eight-week period during the 2020 calendar year. Preference will be given to projects that stress collaboration with Columbia faculty and use of available research resources at Columbia University and in New York City. Applicants may represent any academic discipline or professional school.

### **ABOUT THE INSTITUTE OF LATIN AMERICAN STUDIES**

The Institute of Latin American Studies, founded in 1962, supports research and teaching related to Latin America throughout Columbia University and serves as the University's main point of contact with Latin America. The Institute provides visiting scholars, students and faculty access to the resources available through the schools within the University, such as: the School of International and Public Affairs, the Law School, the Business School, the School of Public Health, and Teachers College, among others.

**TERMS**: The O'Gorman Visiting Scholar Program supports four to eight week visits to Columbia by distinguished scholars, scientists, and intellectuals in Mexican institutions of higher education. The Fellowship covers round trip economy-class air travel to New York plus accommodation in a Columbia University apartment for the duration of the visitor's stay. A per diem equal to \$50/day will be made during the visit period.

#### **APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE:**

- 1) PROPOSAL: A 3-4 page description of the proposed project including specific references to Columbia faculty and research resources.
- 2) REFERENCES: Two letters of recommendation from outside scholars in the field, and a note of acknowledgement from a member of the Columbia faculty who will be collaborating with the applicant.
